AEC aims to create a workplace with zero
accidents by ensuring that every employee

traffic safety training sessions twice a month in
both Japanese and English.

We invite officers from the Ginowan Police Station and members of the Ginowan District Traffic Safety Association as guest lecturers. Through real-life discussions and Q&A sessions, we continuously update our knowledge and raise awareness. Additionally, we use simulators for hazard prediction training.

By the end of 2025, we plan for all employees to complete traffic safety training.
